Growing the PSSP membership – Cape Breton University (CBU)

HALIFAX, NS - Public Service Superannuation Plan Trustee Inc. (PSSPTI) is pleased to announce that 201 employees of Cape Breton University (CBU) have commenced participation in the Public Service Superannuation Plan (PSSP) effective April 1, 2017.

These CBU employees represent almost 60% of the membership of the University's existing defined contribution retirement plan.

Growing the PSSP membership to promote long-term financial sustainability is a key strategic focus for PSSPTI.

CBU is just one of several of the Province's universities to join the PSSP since the PSSPTI began its membership growth initiative in 2015. Other universities that have joined the PSSP include Acadia University, University of Kings College, and Université Sainte-Anne.

PSSPTI is continuing to pursue growth opportunities and is in discussions with several public sector employers about joining the PSSP.
